*Global Sustainability: The Social, Economic and Environmental Health of Commonwealth Nations*

Many nations of the British Empire now belong to the Commonwealth. They represent all regions of the world and levels of development. Examine the Commonwealth nations to explore economic and social problems that face countries of the world, why these problems occur, and the possibility of change. Study the legacy of colonialism; variations in well-being of countries around the world; and policies and programs that promote civil society and economic, social and environmental sustainability.

*The Anglo-American Heritage and Social Well-Being*

The Anglo-American countries share more than the English language and their historic ties to Great Britain. They differ from industrialized societies in their legal traditions, approach to social welfare, and social outcomes including the well-being of their citizenry. Examine these differences historically and in modern times. Explore the experiences of children, focusing on poverty, employment and unemployment, education, delinquency and crime, health, and social support and programs.
